FTP Rules & Policy

Rules:

- 1. Users should not upload any executable, program codes or databases without prior approval
- 2. Users must adhere to the File Management Naming policy & this policy for all directories & files that are created
- 3. SysAd will review all files and directories; non-compliance will result in deletion. SysAd assumes no responsibility or liability for improper implementation of this naming policy; it is the end user's full responsibility
- 4. SysAd will maintain an audit log and reserves the right to audit usage policy

Policies:

1. Directory Structure:

All Projects should have a folder existing on the root directory, the folder is to be created by the individual uploading content to the FTP.

2. Folder Names:

- a. All folder names MUST be lower-case
- b. For one word project names, the folder name will be the project name
- c. For two or more word project names, the folder name will be the project name with an underscore between the words

Examples:

CORRECT: irreversi deep_gold midnight_movie ftv_model_month INCORRECT: Deep-Gold deep gold midnight-Movie ftv-model month

3. Sub-Directories:

All projects should utilize sub-directories and not create other root level directories. This includes sub directories such as final_mix, archive, and other directories that are related to the project

4. Archiving:

Any previous version that is on the ftp server MUST be Deleted or Moved to the archive directory that is within the project directory. This should occur at the same time a new file is being uploaded. Only files that are deemed necessary should be archived.
